This letter is in response to your inquiry regarding the possibility of obtaining fire protection services from the Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians' Fire Department of the Rincon Reservation for a proposed casino and hotel facilities to be constructed on a parcel of property located at the intersection of California State Highway 76 and Sengme Oaks Road.

The Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians' Fire Department would be willing to provide fire protection services to the casino and hotel facilities, subject to an agreement being reached at a later date with the La Jolla Band of Luiseño Indians which is satisfactory to the Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians in regard to capital and operational cost participation and/or reimbursement for providing such services.

The Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians understands that the use of varying fire apparatuses may be called to respond during an incident which would be necessary to provide adequate fire protection for a casino and intensive use high-rise facility such as a hotel.
